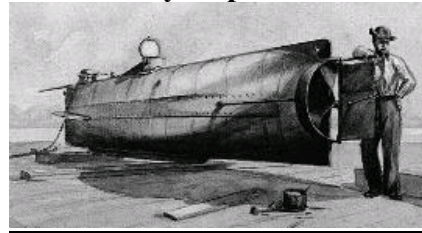

General Gordon was elected Commander-in-Chief when the organization was formed in 1890, a position he held until his death in 1904. He was succeeded by Lt. Gen. Stephen Dill Lee. In 1896, a successor organization, the Sons of Confederate Veterans, was formed by sons of UCV members.
